University Residence

The Dalhousie University will be holding 50 single rooms for the CFQ Society.

Note, you have until May 20 for reservations. All rooms that are not reserved by this date will be released from their hold.

Rate is approx \$43.86/night or \$263.14/week

Hotels suggestions- there are many hotels to choose from in Halifax harbour downtown area and here are a few that we viewed for you. Please note, hotel rates really increase and book up in summer months so it is recommended to book in advance.

Bus route to Saint Mary's University walk one block over to Barrington St.

to take Bus # 10
